My name is Dalene and I am your visiting school nurse for 2014. My role as school nurse involves maintaining the health of the school community. Priority areas include lower primary hearing and vision screenings, assistance with care planning for medical conditions, provisions of immunisation programmes (in high schools for year 8's), along with health education and promotion for the whole school community (students, teachers and parents/care givers).

Consent forms for kindy health screening will be sent out very shortly and need to be returned ASAP so that screening can commence in term 2.

If you have any concerns about your child's health and general well-being, please do not hesitate to contact me either through your school, or at my office on 97 770 400 or email at dalene.read@health.wa.gov.au. My availability is usually Thursday and Fridays.

Student health conditions

It is important that the school is aware of all student health conditions and medical issues, along with any medications that the child may need to take while at school. Please ensure that you provide the school with an updated medical needs form, and that any medications held by the school are not past their expiry date (including puffers).

Immunisations

It is a department of education requirement that parents/caregivers must provide evidence of up to date immunisation status when a child is enrolled. The evidence required is an ACIR certificate that is sent out after the child has their 4 year old immunisations (they can be given at 3 ½). If a new certificate is required you can contact *ACIR either online or ring 1800 653 809* (free call).

The community health team are currently working through the school to update immunisation records of all students. Letters will be sent home over the next few weeks to parents of students who have not provided evidence of up to date immunisations.

In the event of a confirmed case of measles in a school, the WA dept of Health require that all children who have not received/or proof of receiving 2 doses of measles/mumps and rubella (MMR) to be excluded from school for 14 days after the last reported case of measles.

Children that have missed any vaccinations are able to visit their local GP, or immunisation clinic to arrange a 'catch up' of any missed vaccines.

School bases vaccinations

Years 8's are to receive routine school based immunisation in 2014. These will occur in terms 1, 2 and 3. Consent forms have been sent out and these need to be returned ASAP.
